(1) Nicknamed "Twin"

Thomas who was called Didymus

- ▲ Thomas = Aramaic for "twin"
- ▲ Didymus = Greek for "twin"

(2) Likely a fisherman

John 21:2-3

Simon Peter, Thomas (called Didymus), Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples were together. "I'm going out to fish" ...

(3) Man of courage

- Let us also go, that we may die with him." (John 11:16)
- ▲ If they kill him, they'll have to kill me too.

(4) No Easy Answers


Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you.
